*We are located near the boundaries of several school districts  
and must honor the age requirements set by each one.  
To be eligible for the three year old class, a child must be two years away  
from entering kindergarten in the district where he or she lives.  
Four year olds must be eligible for kindergarten in one year.*

## **Classes**

- I. **3-year olds:** 3 by district cut-off date  
(Trains & Rockets) T - Th ⇒ 9:00 to 11:30 am  
Max. 38 children (2 classes of 19) with three teachers each class
- II. **4-year olds:** 4 by district cut-off date  
(Caterpillars) Mon -Wed-Fri ⇒ 9:00 to 11:30 am  
Maximum 23 children with three teachers
- III. **4-year olds:** 4 by district cut-off date  
(Butterflies) Mon-Wed-Fri ⇒ 12:30 to 3:00 pm  
Maximum 23 children with three teachers
- IV. **ARTS PROGRAM**  
**3 and 4 year olds:** 3 & 4 by district cut-off date  
(Fireflies) T - Th ⇒ 12:30 to 3:00 pm  
Maximum 23 children with three teachers
- V. **5 and older 4 year olds:** 5 by January 31st  
(Dinosaurs) T - Th - Fri ⇒ 12:30 to 3:00 pm  
Maximum 23 children with three teachers
- VI. **Additional Pre-K Skills Class** (only open to Caterpillars and Dinosaurs )  
(Explorers) Mondays ⇒ 12:30 to 3:00pm  
Maximum 23 children with three teachers

***A typical day includes:***

- A balance of free play and structure
- Music
- Arts and crafts
- Flag salute and a simple prayer
- Lesson of the day
- Story time
- Snack
- Clean up
- Playground time (weather permitting)

***A typical week may include:***

- Focus on science, nature, community or self
- Cutting
- Numbers, shapes, color and/or alphabet awareness
- Pre-reading and pre-writing skills
- Show and tell
- Painting
- Gross motor development
- Fine motor development
- Organized group games and activities
